





The purpose of this letter is to introduce you to your emergency ground and air ambulances which provide service to Amador and Calaveras counties. Medical emergencies can happen to anyone at any time. Your ground ambulance is provided by American Legion Ambulance and your local air ambulance providers are PHI & AirMedCare Network, which includes CALSTAR & REACH. In recognition of the overlapping service areas, American Legion Ambulance, PHI, AirMedCare Network/CALSTAR/REACH have entered into an agreement to offer a combination ground/air annual membership program for \$190 per year/per household. For those of you that prefer to only enroll in air ambulance membership, the California Farm Bureau entered into an agreement with AirMedCare Network, offering an annual household membership for emergent air medical transport at a discounted rate of \$55 per year for the entire household. Air ambulances play a critical part in saving lives, providing advanced life support while transporting patients from sending hospitals to specialty hospitals, or from the scene of an accident or critical illness to the closest trauma center. An AMCN membership ensures that the patient will have no out-of-pocket expense for medically necessary transports provided by any AMCN provider, which includes CALSTAR & REACH the largest network of air ambulances in California. AirMedCare Network also offers an annual membership program for recuperation air medical transport. If you are hospitalized more than 150 nautical miles from your home, anywhere within the 48 contiguous United States, the Fly-U-Home Program will coordinate and provide air medical transport from a sending hospital to a receiving hospital of your choosing within your home demographics, allowing you to recuperate near family and friends.
